SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 8:00am-noon

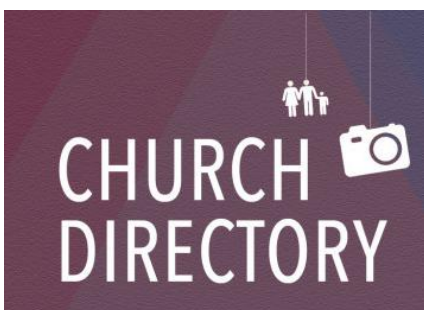
Help us beautify the church grounds from 8:00am-noon. Join us as you are able. There is work for every skill level!
