August 2010 Monthly Newsletter



There was a little boy standing on the bank of the Mississippi River. He was waving and shouting at a big steamboat that was passing by, trying to call it ashore.

A stranger walking by, stopped and said, "You're wasting your energy, young man. That big boat will never stop for you. The captain is too busy to even notice your waving and shouting."

Just then the boat turned and headed for shore. The little boy grinned and said to the stranger, "The captain is my daddy."

Our ìDaddyî in heaven pays attention to us when we pray because He loves us. He notices us. Jesus taught us to begin our prayers with ìOur FatherÕî

People have a lot of questions about prayer. Sometimes people get discouraged with ìunanswered prayers,î even to the point of losing their faith. They may have prayed so earnestly and with every ounce of faith they could muster for a loved one, but what they had hoped for didn't happen. They ask, ìwhat's the point in praying?î

People have a lot of misunderstandings about prayer, some of them almost superstitious. Like the Peanuts cartoon where Charlie Brown is kneeling beside his bed for prayer. He suddenly stops and says to Lucy, "I think I've made a new theological discovery. If you hold your hands upside down, you get the opposite of what you pray for!"

Jesus' disciples had questions about prayer. They said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray." Their request wasn't because He had been teaching about prayer, but as we read in Luke 11, it came when they saw Jesus praying. They saw how important it was to Him. They saw the power of prayer.

Henry Emerson Fosdick wrote, "Note that this awakened interest in prayer came not at all from new arguments about it, but from a new exhibition of its power. Here, before their very eyes, they saw a personality in whom prayer was vital and influential! The more they lived with Him, the more they saw that they could never explain Him or understand Him unless they understood His praying...not at all because of new arguments, but because of amazing spiritual power released in Him by prayer. They wanted Him to tell them how to pray."

For the disciples, the answer to their request about prayer was answered by looking directly to Jesus who modeled prayer for them.

We may never have all our questions about prayer answered, but as we look to Jesus and His Word, we discover that there is great value and power in prayer.

God bless you as you nurture your personal prayer life this summer! The ìCaptainî of the universe will see you needing His attention and will respond because He is the Father who loves you.
