Creating a Redeemed World



When you read all the distressing news about global and local events, do you ever get the feeling of hopelessness and despair? This is an easy and understandable feeling. However, it is not the response that Jesus calls us to claim when we have His eyes and heart for the world.

Recently, I have been reading the book entitled *The Hole in Our Gospel*, written by the president of World Vision, Richard Stearns. Stearns makes a compelling case that all of us who are members of Christian churches in the United States have the resources and capability to do so much more than we do to alleviate poverty and suffering around the world. The barrier that we face sometimes is within our theology, which focuses more upon planning for the afterlife and looking forward to heaven than upon bringing God's kingdom to earth.

Stearns explains how God brought him kicking and screaming from his life as a wealthy corporate CEO to a new life leading World Vision and serving the poorest of the poor in our world. In speaking of "thy kingdom come" from the Lord's Prayer, Stearns says, "This is not to be a far-off and distant kingdom to be experienced only in the afterlife. Christ's vision was of a redeemed world order populated by redeemed people - now. To accomplish this, we are to be salt and light in a dark and fallen world, the yeast that leavens the whole loaf of bread (the whole of society). We are the ones God has called to be His Church. It's up to us. We are to be the change."

As we embark upon the fall season and all of the events that go with it, may we pause and ask God to use us to bring His kingdom to earth. We have to ask ourselves if those around us can see Christ's hope, compassion, mercy, and grace in the way we live our lives. Are we able to reflect the light of Christ so that others are drawn to us because of our positive and uplifting spirit? Or do we too often allow fear and bitterness to prevent us from being Christ's hands and feet on earth? Whenever we start to complain about any situation, may we pause and ask God what we can do to bring hope and a positive spirit to replace despair. With God's guidance, we can be the change the world needs. By God's grace, we can do it! His grace is indeed sufficient!

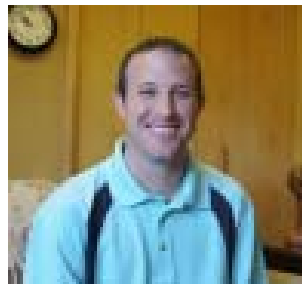

LAKWOOD HOLY LAND TOUR

Several Lakewood people have asked Bill & Carolyn Sherman about forming a Lakewood group to go to Israel in 2011. If we have at least 35 people, the Shermans will lead a group to leave before the end of February and to return before Lent begins in early March. By having our own group, we will have our own bus and guide, and we can set our own itinerary to include some biblical sites not normally included in the basic tour. The cost for the 11-day trip is just under \$2000 from New York for all transportation, excellent accommodations, and meals. Adding flight to New York, entrance fees, taxes, and tips, the total cost is nearly \$3000. There are also optional extensions if you want to have additional time in Jerusalem or Egypt or Jordan.
